After several meetings with base officials, the AFFF is excited to announce the installation of a picnic pavilion. This pavilion will be equipped with tables and barbeque pits. We hope that families will be able to hold gatherings, parties, birthdays and other celebrations at this special area.

Another exciting project in the works is at the USO facility at Tampa International Airport. We are currently working with the USO to help furnish and supply the airport lounge with necessities for traveling service members and their families. The AFFF is providing sofas, recliners, tables, and desks as well as various kitchen equipment and electronics. Our goal is to help the USO of Tampa International Airport make service members feel like they have a "Home away From Home."
