Summer has arrived in full swing and the Armed Forces Families Foundation has made huge strides so far this year!

## **We are proud to share the updates on several recently completed projects including:**

1. The Camp Blanding Family and Solider Assistance Center in Jacksonville held a ribbon cutting event on May 14<sup>th</sup> after a \$40,000 renovation of the Center was completed!
2. The USO of South Carolina renovation has been completed, with a grand reopening ribbon cutting event held on May 30<sup>th</sup>. With two other renovation projects being accomplished, we held ribbon cutting events on June 11<sup>th</sup> in Pensacola at both the NAS Pensacola USO Center and the Northwest Florida Regional Airport USO Center.

## **Our team has many impactful projects in the works including:**

1. The Haley VA Hospital day room is under construction and will allow for families to gather and spend time with one another in a comfortable space. It is projected to be completed in October 2013.
2. The Charlotte VA Medical Center bowling alley renovation is scheduled for completion in August 2013.
3. The Moody Air Force Base Family Housing game room project has been approved and is now on the way towards completion.

## **Future projects may include:**

1. Survivor Outreach Services Facility Family Center (Orlando)
2. Miami Veterans Center Mental Health Unit Relaxation Room (Miami)
3. Army YMCA Center Renovation (Nashville)

Additionally, through our partnership with the Jacksonville Sharks, we were able to raise over \$30,000 at the 2013 Jacksonville Sharks Military Night event! The proceeds from the Military Appreciation Night event will be used towards our current project at Jacksonville University, where we are constructing a study room for students using the G.I. Bill.

We would like to thank everyone for making these projects possible and of course our greatest appreciation goes out to our military service men and women as well as their supporting families.
